

- 1 Bewilderwood Treehouse Adventure. A huge forest of family fun and outdoor adventure. Cycle hire.
- 2 Hoveton Hall Gardens. Woodland and lakeside walks and walled garden. Open Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Sunday and Bank Holidays. Easter to September.
- 3 Wroxham Barns. Shops, crafts, café, craft exhibitions and demonstrations, and children's play area. Toilets. Entrance fee to children's farm.
- 4 Trips available around Barton Broad on the solar boat, Ra.
- 5 Barton Broad. On the boardwalk you will be able to go right into the mysterious floating forest of Herons' Carr and have good views over Barton Broad. Lock your bikes up at the entrance.
- 6 Irstead Church and Irstead Shoals Staithe. The church has one of the oldest rood screens in Norfolk. From the staithe enjoy views of the River Ant and Shoals Dykes.
- 7 RAF Air Defence Radar Museum. Varied displays showing the history and development of the radar.
- 8 Bure Valley Path. A nine mile cycle path alongside the Bure Valley Steam Railway to Aylsham.
